APPLIED BEHAVIOR ANALYSIS TECHNICIAN

Who is this Coursework most suitable for?

This approved Coursework is suitable for anyone wishing to implement ABA treatment plans for an individual with Autism. The Coursework teaches behavioral intervention in home, community and school settings to increase communication, social, play, academic and daily living skills, while reducing inappropriate behaviors.

- What are the eligibility criteria needed to enrol in this Coursework?
 You need to be at least 18 years old and possess a high school leaving diploma.
- Will I be a certified ABAT® at the end of this Coursework?

No. To be a certified ABAT®, you will need to complete the approved Coursework, pass the exam and meet the 15 hours of fieldwork under the supervision of a professional who is certified within the scope of ABA and Autism. The eligibility criteria to be certified ABAT® is also more extensive and is available here. As a certified ABAT®, your credential information will be published in QABA's online registry.

Please note that to pursue the credential, you will need to fulfill the Course Completion requirements set by QABA. If you are unable to fulfill these requirements, you may still participate in the Course but will not be eligible to receive the Certificate of Course Completion.

Can I attend the Course without pursuing Certification?

Yes, you can! While we encourage participants to complete the certification process, it is not a requirement. At SEED Autism Services, we believe in empowering the community with the right knowledge and skillsets. Certification may not be for everyone. For example, you may be in a setting where obtaining supervision long-term is not possible. But you may still be keen in learning and upgrading skills and techniques required to implement ABA treatment plans effectively.

- Is there value in obtaining the ABAT® certification then?

 Most definitely. While it may not be necessary for everyone to walk down the exam and certification path, it does open up employment opportunities and credibility in this field, be it in the local scene or internationally. More importantly, there is tremendous value in upgrading skills to enable you to

What is SEED's role in this program?

SEED Autism Services is an <u>Approved Coursework Provider</u> for ABAT®, which means we essentially conduct the Course. During the orientation session, we will also guide candidates in the procedures involved for obtaining certification. However, candidates will be responsible for their exam, supervision and renewal arrangements, and are therefore highly encouraged to read up on the published information on QABA website.



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Mode of Learning

This is an online course. To keep the lessons interactive and varied, we will be using a few channels to communicate on and deliver the lessons to all participants:

- A Whatsapp group will be formed for participants and instructors of your intake
- Slides, study guides and accompanying videos will be available on Thinkific on Mondays
- Compulsory discussion question and study guide must be submitted by Friday noon
- Tutorials will be conducted via Google Meet on Saturdays as scheduled for the intake

Course Completion Requirements

- Important: Attend the orientation
- Watch all pre-recorded lectures (provide key words embedded within lectures)
- Complete all assigned tasks
- Attend all live tutorials as per published dates
 - Only 2 make-up classes allowed;
 - Candidate must make-up the class by watching recorded session
- Pass Quiz at the end of course (Passing criteria: 70%)
- Participants who do not meet these requirements will not be eligible to receive the Certificate of Course Completion



Course Description

The ABAT® Course provides the knowledge and skills to equip an entry-level interventionist who typically serve as direct care one-to-one instructor. This Course is **one** of the requirements to be certified as an Applied Behaviour Analysis Technician (ABAT) by the Qualified Applied Behaviour Analysis Credentialing Board (QABA). At the end of this Course, upon meeting all Course completion requirements successfully, you will receive a Certificate of Course Completion from SEED Autism Services. *The Certificate of Course Completion is not the same as ABAT® credential. However, it is one of the prerequisites to obtaining the ABAT® credential.*
